Target Audience

Encouraging Learning Skills is a programme aimed at Teaching Assistants.

Programme Outline

Communication skills are essential for learning across the whole school curriculum. Encouraging Learning Skills is a programme of three modules for Teaching Assistants who want to encourage the development of key communication skills—listening, language and speech—in all children as part of everyday learning activities.

Aims of the Programme

This programme is aimed at providing an overview of good practice within the classroom to help children to develop these essential communication skills. The programme is delivered in workshop style sessions and consists of three sessions of 1.5 hours each. The modules are as follows:

- Module 1—**Listening Skills**
- Module 2—**Language Skills**
- Module 3—**Speech Skills**
