### Target Audience

This programme is for teachers who are, or have the potential and capacity to deliver consistently outstanding lessons. This programme is crucial for teachers involved in developing Leadership in Teaching and Learning.

### Aims

- Be able to demonstrate higher level understanding of teaching and improve learning for their pupils and school
- Be able to coach colleagues in their own school in order to raise performance and impact on outcomes
- To create a proactive school culture where quality of teaching and learning is observed, discussed, challenged and enhanced
- To increase job satisfaction and create opportunities for further leadership and career progression.

### What does it involve?

The **OTP** is a 7 session programme which runs over 10 weeks (5x 3 hours—morning sessions, 2x full days—6 hours each). It is delivered through face-to-face taught sessions, classroom observations within the host schools and in-school practice sessions at the participant's school.

- Some external recognition (e.g. Threshold of Ofsted grades) that indicate that they have the ability to become outstanding teachers.
- A commitment to professional development and the ability to truly reflect on their practice including using student feedback to evaluate the impact of their teaching.
